#### Open Discussion

- Better Ways to Recycling
  - Rob: lack of education/posters. Residence Halls do a good job, other parts are not as prevalent.
  - Nick: how would you fix it?
  - Rob: more posters, larger posters, pictures for what can go in each section
  - Sam: feeling rushed in a dining halls
  - Rob: all you care to eat, there's always a long line
  - Nick: finals week numbers significantly drop
  - John: sustainability should the data, which kind of bin would you like in your room. Increase recycling put a bin in your room.
  - Rob: make sure the trash can is still there. Use both
  - John: decrease floor space being used
  - Sam: great idea, trouble emptying it regularly. Might be counter productive
  - Kayla: the pilot failed, same amount of trash, not recycling being done. A lot of kids don't care
  - Cameron: categorize the waste in different areas, coffee cup outside the coffee shop

- John Hurst: have the option to ask for a recycling bin for the room. Give a prize at the end of the semester for an incentive, but don't tell them. Advertize!
- Maria: not enough people care. I like the option have a recycling bin in the room. Scare tactic, convenience level and social level, have more events for awareness. Make a new norm
- Rob: I give out candy when I see people recycling and they go crazy for it
- Nick: how do you keep track as an RA?
- Rob: big candy bar for the first time, tallies for each subsequent time. Room that recycles the most gets a prize. 5-8% of RAs would actually keep up with this
- John Hurst: shame does not work. Incentives work!
- Brad: incentive is a good idea, the habit will stick after college
- Rob: 6 weeks to get a habit to stick
- Laura: events are a good idea
- Kayla: get it in the freshman's heads. Incentivize the RAs?
- Nick: they measure it in bags
- Laura: Incentivize an RA
- John Hurst: Incentivize a student on their floor, someone who is passionate. They take out the recycling and they'll be the ones talking to the floor
- John: a lot of people have never recycled before, or just have single stream recycling
- Maria: hub lawn: make a pile of all the bottles that would have been recycled but were thrown in the trash for awareness. Some type of recycled art.
- RA Legislation
  - Rob: have you gathered interest in RAs?
  - John: yes, casual interest
  - Rob: having too many positions and not enough people to fill them
  - NickO: I have talked to RAs about getting involved too, gets back channeled because they don't know about us. Introducing it as an ad-Hoc position
  - Rob: I don't know if RAs are going to want to add on something else to do
  - Andrew: semester of experience, not necessarily important if they are expressing interest
  - John: experience in the areas so they can speak on what is going on in the area
  - Mitch: able to attend area government meeting, one position per area?
  - John: yes
  - Kayla: form a committee and submit one agenda?
  - Kyle: one agenda for the 6 areas
  - Nick: 9 supergroups in east, how do you disseminate information? Meeting once a month doesn't make it feasible
  - John: area rab meetings: west/north, purpose is to be here and speak on the problems
  - NickO: changing this is no problem
  - Nick: RA structure is too large for this to go into effect well
  - John Hurst: structure thing, why are we doing this?
  - Rob: do you want more RA involvement?
  - John: I wanted to create more RA involvement and ARHS, more incentive if there is a position
  - Leigh: appointed by the coordinator?
  - NickO: interest
  - Nick: Rob already comes so he's our guy
  - John: more involved because of the people who are already here
  - Nick: remove the restriction that you can't be president if you're an RA

- John Hurst: ResLife will not let them, RAs are already leaders. If you take away opportunities people won't partake
- Maria: keep in mind to market to people who are not involved already, push to get people who are not involved
- Rob: Mark, opinions?
- Mark: communication! RAs are busy and adding things to people's plate is not easy. Having someone from ARHS talking to Central Rab. Is there a balance?
- John: what should we change?
- Nick: would they come to the meetings? Discussions will be skewed to RAs
- John: they can't vote.
- Nick: ¼-⅓ of the discussion will be skewed
- NickO: differences in the ages for representation, but it's about the areas they are representing
- Nick: ideas will come from other RAs
- NickO: what if 6 person group but 1 person comes
- Maria: solves the problem of adding more to the RA
- Julia: the point is to have a direct link between RAs and ARHS? Wouldn't that undermine their area government
- NickO: trying to open the lines of communication more, not just to areas but to council
- Kayla: have them go to the area governments and have the President bring the info to ARHS
- John: adds a middle man
- Kayla: now they are adding two more meetings
- John: introduce flexibility they have to come to ARHS once every 6 weeks, a cycle
- Brian: RAs from east have to go to meetings, they don't talk
- NickO: get rid of the requirement
- Mitch: usually an RA comes, only reason why they talk is when they are specifically asked something
- John: they don't see a lot of what we do, if they come here they might find it more interesting.
- Cameron: change who it would be under
- Kyle: they would report to someone temporarily
- Andrew: strongly encourage sending one of us to them as opposed to creating a new position
- Julia: during that, encourage them to go to their area government for problems
- Nick: how are you planning to approach RAs?
- NickO: go to supergroups, Rab
- NickO: revisions will be made and presented next week or the following
- Kayla: have you gotten any response from RAs?
- NickO: have not put it out to a majority of RAs, adding a survey to rate interest?
- Kayla: if the majority of RAs don't want to do it, the position won't be filled
- Rob: mention it in RA classes
- Maria: having an agenda, but not required to come to the meeting
- When do you want to go to East?
  - Rob: pick a date and tell us we are doing it
- Thespians Budget Request
  - Rob: we have always supported them in the past
  - Mitch: free ticket is a plus

- Cameron: how will they know we are in ARHS
- NickO: sign up fast!
- Caribbean Student Association
  - Mitch: interesting event, diverse and we should support
  - Cameron: great alternative to State Patty's
  - Nick: disappointed that it's \$20 for students
  - Kayla: are they making money off of this event?
  - Maria: their estimated attendance they would break even
- Casino Night Budget Request
  - Rob: Laura paid for it so we should reimburse her
- Concealment of money from last semester
  - NickO: there was a clerical error, solved the problem in the day. Didn't think it would cause a huge issue.
  - Nick: I don't believe it to be true
  - NickO: we didn't know ahead of time, and we got the checks from OCM that day. We have the best intentions of this council at heart
  - Nick: on the 31st October didn't come to the meeting, why didn't we get the account balance?
  - NickO: people forget to do things sometimes
  - Nick: why did we find out about this now?
  - NickO: it wasn't a large concern
  - Nick/Rob: we should have been notified why you found out
  - NickO: we had the financial problem, miscommunication between what number was being reported. No one on the board knew about it until end of November, when we got the checks from OCM.
  - Nick: when did we get the check from OCM?
  - NickO: that day
  - Nick: you were off by two months
  - NickO: the correct balance was reported
  - Kyle: That is Sangeeth's error
  - Nick: it's his job to give a detailed report once per semester
  - David: the longer it was left, the less council is to trust you
  - NickO: I apologize, we see that this has been an error on our ways
  - Mitch: I understand there was a mistake, we should have been informed
  - Kayla: this wasn't a big issue, but no one knew and now it's a big deal
  - Andrew: transparency is key, and this is a depressing moment. I don't feel I can trust the exec board to make these types of decisions anymore
  - Nick: balance should be reported every meeting, deliberately kept private
  - Kyle: not deliberately kept private
  - Nick: my comment is not there
  - Leigh: nothing gets omitted
  - Nick: you don't feel like you have to tell us
  - John: nothing gets removed
  - NickO: clarification: we apologize, it was fixed and we did not think that we did not need to approach this clerical error. However, this has been blown out of proportion, it was an error that we did not bring it to your attention
  - Nick: \$30K not a small error, reason to believe that checks did bounce: Mitch's money
  - John Hurst: trust is important, doesn't always lie with the exec board

- Maria: it wasn't something that registered as a big deal, and i can understand that. Not something that we should be deeply concerned about
- NickO: we can come to you if you want to know all the little problems we deal with as an exec board
- Nick: not minor, it's your responsibilities to report to us. Opposite of transparency, i cast a vote on a platform of transparency.
- NickO: can we regain your trust, where do we go from here?
- Nick: are you insinuating you are going to resign
- NickO: if council calls for it, I will. I hope to regain your trust
- Rob: motions for the impeachment of Kyle Shuey
- NickO: wait till new business?
- Kyle: explaining impeachment
