- Matt Beyen: I think we should look into UPUA's old logo as an example for our new one. It has Penn State represented in it as well as their organization. It's less boring than our logo.
- o Cameron Francis: On the rectangle discussion, I think we should alter the colors on that.
- Laura Daly: That was just what it would look like on a jacket. (referring to NRHH Jacket)
- Nick Mahon: What is associated with ARHS? I think us talking about the logo is a little trivial. There are better things we can do with our time.
- Akhil D: Why is the Old Main thing associated with UPUA and can't be associated with us?
- Laekin: I disagree, I think it's important to talk about logos. It's the first thing people see when they talk about us.
