Open Discussion: Council returned at 7:30pm

- RA Liaison
 - Robert: What is your idea or intention with this position? One goal?
 - John: The main goal was to improve communication between RAs, ARHS and Residence Life.
 - Nick: We know there are a lot of RAs in this room, however, we are concerned that in the future that voice might not be heard
 - Jaden: In terms of looking for requirements, one is they should have completed at least one year as an RA. In addition, be an RA.
 - Laura: Each area has a meeting with their supergroup. Is there a giant meeting ever?
 - Alex: Varies by area, not an often thing
 - John: Do we want this centralized or something more along the lines of an area government level?
 - Robert: I think that RAs will be more likely to come to area government meetings
 - Laura: I want RAs to have a voice, but I think we need multiple RAs coming to ARHS and not the area government meetings
 - Jaden: We have C-RAAB, I would suggest that the RA liaison attend those meetings. In pollock, there is a lot of hostility due to the advisors forcing RAs to recruit people, and etc. Hostility comes from the advisors stepping in.
 - Chris: In east it wasn't an ultimatum, but it was more that RAs don't want to come, same as a junior resident talking to their RA. There is no motivation to attend the meeting, that is where the disconnect occurs.

- Leigh: What about having a representative from ARHS attend the larger RA meetings?
- Laura: Laura Perry has discussed area presidents coming in early to meet with the RAs. I will be attending a supergroup meeting in the future.
- John Hurst: Context -- it started out with Diane feeling that RAs were missing a large part of the student government experience. There used to be more animosity. I think it's important to a) get current RAs to talk to some of their friends and b) give them a purpose. I like the idea of improving relations, but what is the second half?
- Chris: Yield to redundancy. I think Leigh's suggestion would be easier, but have multiple people go to these meetings.
- John: How important is it for this person to be an RA?
 - Jaden: Part of it is dependent on the goal of this position. Start small and increment more depth over the next couple of years.
 - Robert: Mark, is it possible for someone on the executive board to sit in on these meetings?
 - Mark: Anything is possible. I wonder if it would be beneficial to send people to both the area RAABs and C-RAAB.
 - Chris: I think area RAABs is more helpful. Communication is a good goal, but we need a deeper definition. Ask what is working?
