Open Discussion

- Kay's Presentation
 - O Brian: why did you choose 3/4 and 2/3
 - Kay: to keep it the same as previous language
 - NickM: is this the first reading
 - NickO: yes, but if changes are made the next time it would come up would be the first reading again
 - Rob: defining a recommendation is in bullet point A
- Recruitment Chair
 - NickO: no major changes were made, does not require a vote. If there is nothing else that needs to be changed it will go in as a AdHoc position for next year
 - Rob: is a standing committee different from an Ad Hoc
 - NickO: yes, but in this case, it would not matter
 - NickM: is it in the constitution
 - NickO: yes, but it is in it's own section.
 - NickM: is it appointed?
 - NickO: can go either way
 - NickM: because it is AdHoc i feel that it should be appointed

- Kayla: you still vote
- Matt: appointed because it requires some type of experience
- Hannah: is the THON chair appointed or elected? Because if it is appointed i think that it should be.
- Laura: outside people are encouraged to apply for an appointed position
- Rob: when i was on exec two years, Student Wellness was appointed
- Amanda: i feel that PR could do the recruitment
- NickO: despite what people think, it is an extremely important part of this organization and takes up a lot of time
- Amanda: but what PR would do is vital to recruitment
- NickM: a lot of things overlap
- NickO: PR would handle social media, recruitment would work solely on gaining members
- Laura: i was PR before, and i think that recruitment should go with PR
- Cameron: is there a way that it can make it a two factor
- NickO: that is what this is
- Kayla: there are already too many chairs
- Kay: i understand that there is some overlap between PR and Recruitment and i do not think
 the events and the stuff with East would make sense under PR. i think this is a really
 important chair for us to have
- John: PR's job is to coordinate with every chair
- Amanda: that makes it sounds like PR and Recruitment cant work without each other. Which is primarily the promotion of ARHS
- NickO: it's like saying you have a difference between marketing and sales
- Rob: my understanding of PR is to build a relationship with the public, which then turns into recruitment
- O John: we want to avoid the "this could happen" we want to have PR work by extension to recruit people
- Rob: laura, how much of your time was making posters (20mins) i think that people have enough time to recruit at the same time
- Kay: the reason we created this was because we don't have enough people in ARHS. whatever we have isn't working and this is an AdHoc position
- Hannah: recruitment is a problem, if it is under PR it will not be as important as it is. We don't want to have nothing, an AdHoc to see how it goes
- Laura: i just think requirment fits under PR nicely
- Cameron: i feel that we should just get rid of PR which is 10x more important
- Amanda: what we are doing now isn't working, but the reason why it isn't working is because we don't have a PR chair
- Kayla: while this would be an AdHoc, it can be an AdHoc of PR, we could put PR under recruitment instead of recruitment under PR
- John: if we are interested in simplify the amount of chairs we have would complicate it
- Kayla: what is the difference between them then
- NickO: the primary and secondary goals
- John: make it PR & Recruitment
- Rob: we are not able to fill chairs now, i don't think it complicated to combine chairs
- John and kayla: same thing, miscommunication
- Amanda: combining the roles
- John: the issue that we are not able to fill a Recruitment Chair is the same as not filling a PR chair
- Laura: it would be different to fill one instead of two
- John: it is still a divided work effort, i think it is critical to have a person dedicated
- Kayla: i don't see where the hierarchy comes in
- NickO: the issue i see is that Casino Night is not a recruitment event. The recruitment chair would be responsible to plan events to solely recruit
- Brian: everyone thinks that PR is in charge of every event, but their not. Their job is to advertise it not organize it. I don't like 4.11.3

- Laura: there is not much to the responsibility to PR
- Kay: i feel it doesn't make sense to do it that way because that is not what PR does. This is different than PR because it has that programing aspect
- Laura: we are asking for it to be PR & Recruitment
- Kay: i don't think the same type of person that would work in PR be the same person as Recruitment
- David: my position is that the council should have as many position as possible. I think they should stay different. This conversation lasted way longer than it had to because we are AdHocing it anyway
- John: The past PR chairs have never made efforts for recruitment
- NickM: i don't think it is fair to condense chairs because we don't have the people to fill
 it. IE: Sustainability. Do we not want this position because we don't have people to fill them
 or people not doing their job
- Amanda: is creating a new position that needs to be filled by the current members solve the problem. As for EHRA, i don't think that should fall under one chair
- Brian: PR is a back-end thing, where they don't have to be good with people. 4.11.3 is confusing
- NickO: the point is not to be like "hey you're president"
- Rob: *reading constitution*, i interpret that as recruitment
- John: having a chair that is not up for interpretation
- Rob: then expand that, instead of making a new chair
- NickM: was it appointed or elected
- NickO: if we move forward with it will be appointed
- Informal vote for in favor of having a separate chair: 11
- No i want to see this as PR: 5
- NickO: we will proceed to making this an AdHoc position

 - Brian: looks good
- APAC Budget request
 - Cameron: suggest we table it
- Kayla about waiting for doing interviews until we have more exec
 - John: What if you tie?
 - Kayla: that is the reason why i am asking
 - NickM: how is that going to work?
 - Laura: we will talk until we agree
 - Kayla: if we cannot make a decision, we say that a decision has not been made
 - O Brendan: you two were voted in with confidence of council, i think you two should be trusted with the process
 - Cameron: appoint one more person, too make it easier, prioritize certain chairs
 - Laura: if that is ok with you guys
 - Kayla: a concern is no transition period
 - Kay: this is because of NCC with the time constraint. It would make sense to wait till next week and do interviews that weekend, and do this weekend on NCC
 - Rob: did you think about appointed a neutral 3rd party
 - NickO: recommendation: anyone on the exec board now, you can have that acting member until we resign then that cannot be done
 - NickM: leave the position open until, and not interview people
 - NickO: yes they can do that, there is nothing that says you can't hold off on interviews
 - Kayla: we didn't want to do this and have the two of us make the decision. We wanted your opinion
 - Informal vote
 - Totally comfortable with this: 10
 - I don't like this: 1
 - Abstain: 2
 - NickM: What would happen if I ran and Laura abstained
